Journal Article (more than 10 authors, volume only)

Authors (the first ten plus et al.). Article title (Sentence-style capitalization). Journal Title (Headline-Style Capitalization, abbreviated). Year;volume: page range.

von Doom V, Sinister M, Osborn N, Octavius O, Connors C, Starr E, Pym H, Rawlings C, Karza B, Willheim F, et al. Cybertechnology and the evil-doer: a practical guide to becoming a superhuman. *Mad Sci*. 1964;146: 20-35.

Journal Article (up to 10 authors, issue only)

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Article title (Sentence-style capitalization). Journal Title (Headline-Style Capitalization, abbreviated). Year;(issue): page range.

Journal Article (up to 10 authors, issue only [with supplement])

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Article title (Sentence-style capitalization). Journal Title (Headline-Style Capitalization, abbreviated). Year;(issue Suppl supplement letter, if applicable): page range.

West H. Fun with reanimation. *Popul Mad Sci*. 1999;(4 Suppl A): 25-40.

Journal Article (Government Agency as author (no nationality given in the name), volume only [with supplement])

[acronym for agency] Agency Name (country, 2-letter abbreviation). Article title (Sentence-style capitalization). Journal Title (Headline-Style Capitalization, abbreviated). Year;volume Suppl supplement letter, if applicable: page range.

[JL] Justice League (US). Combating mind control. *J Biopsych*. 2004;3 Suppl A: 1-10.

Note 1: A journal may have a "special number" or a "part" (analogous to a supplement). For these, follow the same rules with the supplement with the abbreviations Spec No and Pt, respectively. These normally have numbers as opposed to letters.

Note 2: When there are multiple volume numbers or multiple issue numbers, list them with a hyphen, e.g., 102-103.

Book (up to 10 authors)

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Title (Sentence-style capitalization). Nth ed. City (State/Province or Country [if not US or Canada] 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities): Publisher; Year.

Parts of Books (up to 10 authors, Non-edited Book)

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Book title (Sentence-style capitalization). Nth ed. City (State/Province or Country [if not US or Canada], 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities): Publisher; Year. Chapter/Figure/Table/etc. number (e.g., Chapter 2), Title of the part (Sentence-style capitalization); p. page range.

Fate, D. Mindreading: ethical considerations. 3rd ed. San Francisco: City Lights; 1960. Table 2, Potential damage to the human brain; p. 50.

Parts of Books (up to 10 authors, Edited Book)

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Title of part (Sentence-style capitalization). In: Editors, editors. Book title (Sentence-style capitalization). Nth ed. City (State 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities): Publisher; Year. p. page range.

Woman, W. Mind control: Maxwell Lord. In: Manhunter M, Atom, T, editors. Mad scientists. 10th ed. New York: JL Press;2007. p. 250-265.

Conference Paper

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Paper title (Sentence-style capitalization). In: Editors, editors. Book title (Sentence-style capitalization). Number and Name of Conference (Headline-Style Capitalization); Conference Dates (year month-abbreviated to first three letters day); Conference City, State/Province 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA or Country [if not US or Canada, not abbreviated]. Publisher City (State/Province 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA or Country [if not US or Canada, not abbreviated]): Publisher; Year. p. page range.

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Title [dissertation or thesis]. [City (State 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities)]: Publisher; Year.

Luthor L. Kryptonite: applications [dissertation]. [Smallville]: Smallville University;1962.

Web Document (up to 10 authors, Author different from the website author/authoring organization)

Author(s) (up to and including the tenth author). Title (Sentence-style capitalization) [Internet]. In: Author of the Website (ideally an organization so there is a city and state). Title of the website (capitalization depends on the original). City (State 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities): Author of the website; Year [modified year month day; cited year month day]. Available from: URL.

Web Document (Author same as the website author/authoring organization)

Author of the website (ideally an organization so there is a city and state). Title of the website (capitalization depends on the original). City (State 2-letter abbreviation, e.g., MA, necessary only for less well-known cities): Author of the website; Year. Title of Web document (Sentence-style capitalization) [Internet]; [modified year month day; cited year month day]. Available from: URL.
